The test phase of Delair's DARTS (departure and arrival traffic management system) software product at Fraport AG, operator of Frankfurt Airport, has been concluded successfully. The departure management system was handed over to Fraport and will be commissioned operationally in March 2007. Apart from the airport operator and the airlines, passengers and residents around Frankfurt Airport will benefit from the Departure Manager which optimizes capacity use of the runway system and harmonizes handling processes, considerably reducing waiting times before take-off as well as emissions and fuel burn. Together with co-operation partner DFS, DARTS has been developed into a co-operative arrivals and departures system (darts4D) that is currently in the test phase. DARTS has been used successfully at Zürich Airport for the past four years. -- "The decision for Delair's DARTS has been an important step for Fraport to gear up the Frankfurt hub for future demands," said Martin Lenke, Fraport's Senior Executive Manager Airside Operation. #804.ATC10
